

Agreed Report

May 2022

A normal meeting of St. Vincent's Board of Management took place. The school will resume the Junior Trip in 2023. A number of junior cycle students will travel to Barcelona during the Easter holidays. St. Vincent's will accept up to 78 students in September. The school has a reduced allocation due to Covid hours no longer being available. The allocation has been appealed and pending student numbers an additional .5 of a teaching position will be available. The school has increased its SEN hours. A high number of students have opted to join transition year. The school is currently rolling out a new LCA application process. This has been well received. The school has identified Assessment as its focus for SSE. The SSE focus group is working on a number of specific objectives over the next academic year. The yard space will see an improvement with additional shelter and seating from student. The external and internal doors have been replaced under the summer works scheme.

Post holders shared their end of year review with the Board. The board is set to commence its Annual Review in January 2023. Changes since the last review are the amalgamation of the assessment posts and the introduction of Year Heads.
